

Dear Candidates and Supervisors,

As the Nova Scotia Regulator of Psychology (NSRP) continues its transition under the **Regulated Health Professions Act (RHPA)**, we are pleased to announce the release of our modernized Supervision Reporting Forms.

To ensure that all professional records are legally defensible and reflect current provincial standards, the NSRP has retired all previous versions of the Monthly and Six-Month reports.

Key Updates in the February 2026 Versions:

- **Legislative Alignment:** Knowledge ratings now reflect the RHPA, the General Regulations, and the Psychology Regulations.
- **Verification of Direct Observation:** Dedicated fields to confirm the mandatory observation of candidates providing services to clients.
- **In-Person Requirement:** A simplified tracking mechanism for the "1-in-6" in-person meeting policy.

Implementation Timeline:

- **Effective Immediately:** Candidates and supervisors should download the new forms from the [\[NSRP Supervision Forms & Process Page\]](#) for their next reporting cycle.
- **Transition Period:** Monthly reports must utilize the new format as of March 4th. For Six-Month Reports currently in progress, we will allow a transition window until March 31st, after which all submissions must be on the modernized February 2026 version.

Thank you for your cooperation as we modernize our processes to align with the new provincial framework.
