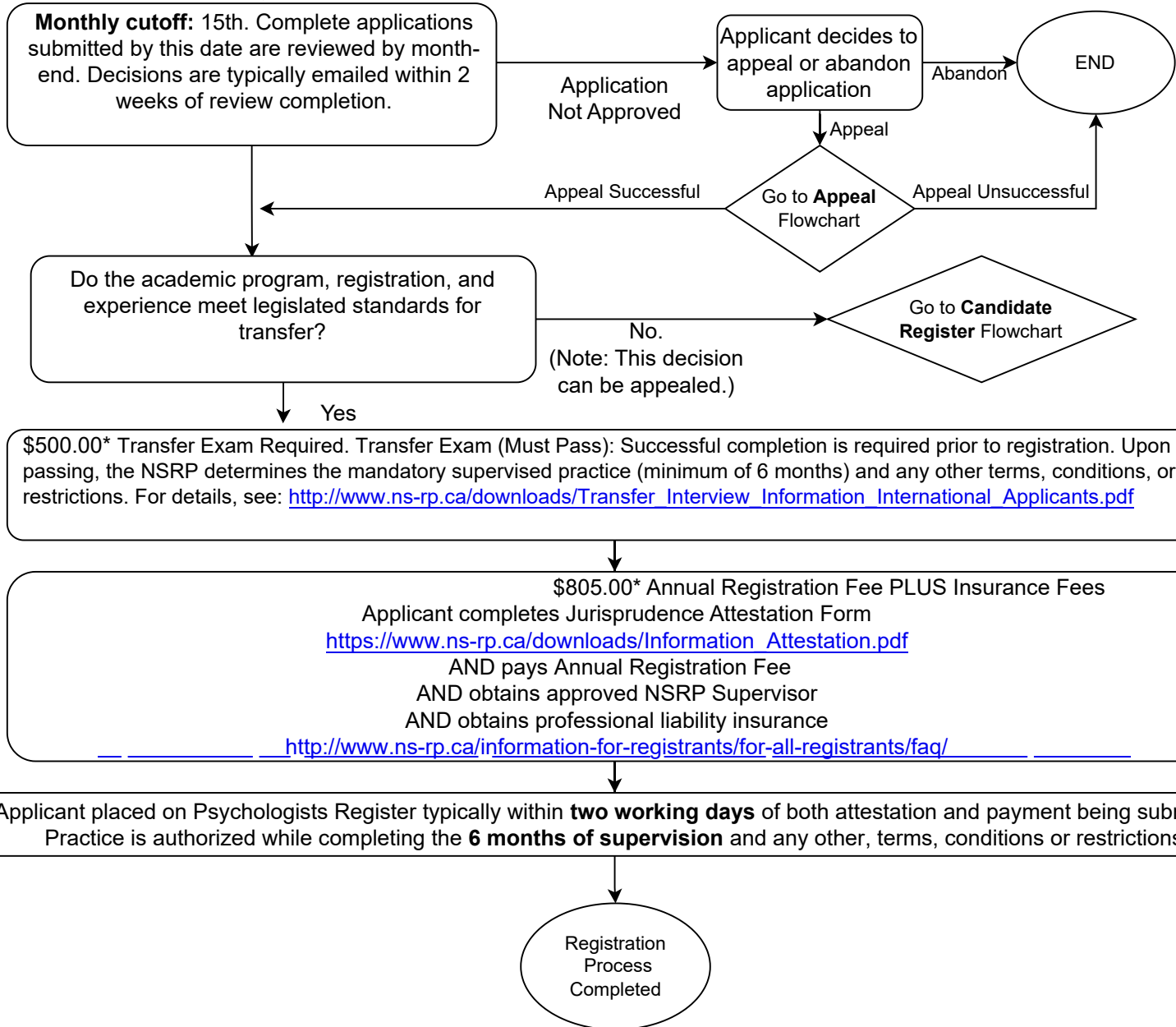


# International Applicant Flowchart

Note: This flowchart will apply to most common situations, but variations can occur.

**\$500.00 USD\***  
 There may be other fees payable to third parties.  
 Application to NSRP begins with submitting required documentation through the ACPRO Portal: <https://acpro-acprp.ca/internationally-educated-applicants/>  
 The portal will compile and authenticate required application documentation including: identity documents; education documents; registration/license documents; language proficiency test results; criminal background check.  
 When the applicant has completed this process, they must authorize the portal to provide their application package to NSRP

**\$250.00\***  
 NSRP staff review applications for completeness and may request additional items like course descriptions or language tests. The **NSRP online form (Nova Scotia-specific)** must also be completed, which can be started at any stage.  
**Note:** the NSRP form is separate from and does not replace the mandatory **ACPRO Portal process**. Final review occurs once all documentation is assembled.

\*\* TA monthly cutoff of the 15th applies for all items (applications/exams). Complete items submitted by the 15th are reviewed by month-end, with results emailed within two weeks.
